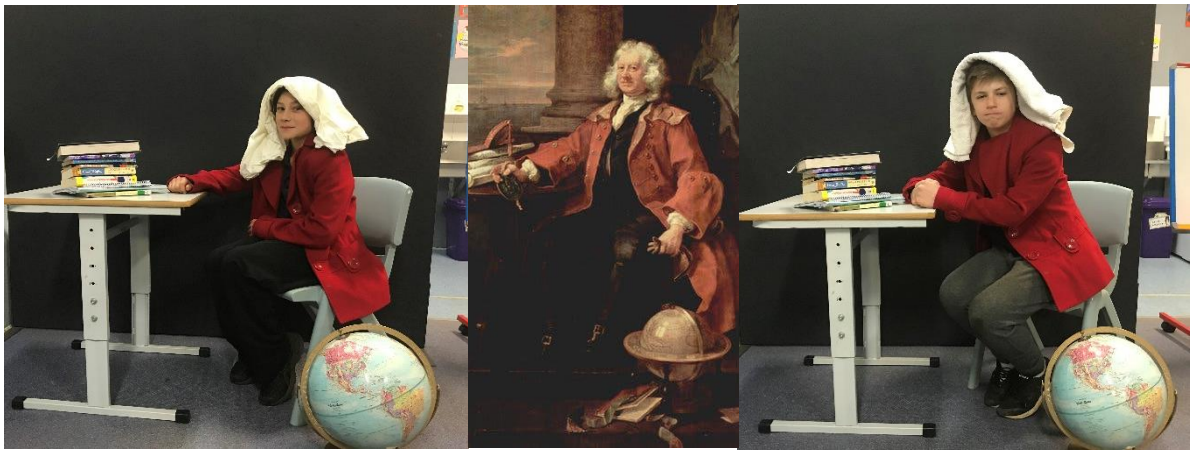
## Upper Primary News

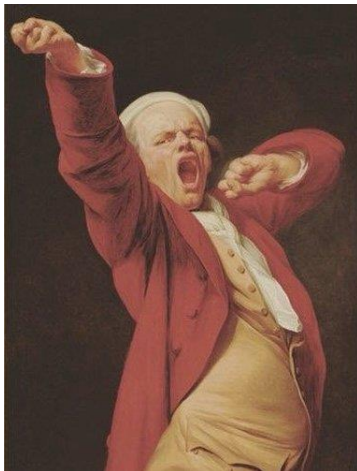
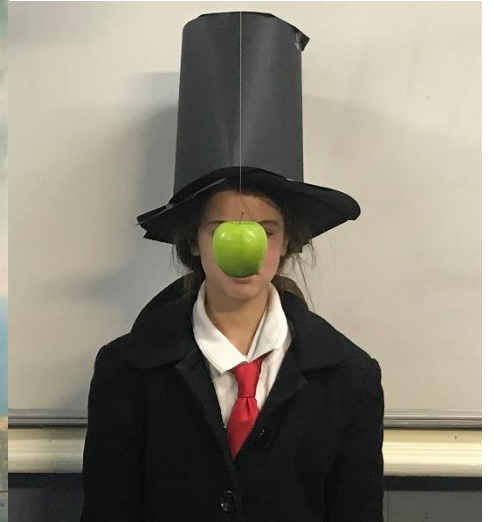


Whistler's Mother
